## **BEST OF BREED COMPETITION**

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

### **GRAND CHAMPION**

Champions of Record and dogs which have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed that are entered in Best of Breed competition are eligible for Grand Championship competition. Grand Championship points may be recorded for: Best of Breed or Best of Variety of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed or Best of Variety of Breed, Select Dog, and Select Bitch. Grand Championship points will be recorded according to the number of eligible dogs competing in the regular and non-regular (eligible for Best of Breed/Variety) classes of each breed or variety, as well as dogs competing in Best of Breed competition, according to the Schedule of Points established by the Board of Directors. (*AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 16, Section 6, effective 11-01-2017*)

### **AWARDS OF MERIT**

Award of Merit Rosettes may be awarded at the discretion of the judge to 10% of the Best of Breed entry including the winners of the non-regular classes who are eligible for Best of Breed competition. The following are not eligible for an Award of Merit: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Winners Dog & Winners Bitch.

### **BEST PUPPY CLASS ELIGIBILITY**

Best Puppy will be selected from the Puppy Class winners (6-9, 9-12) following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated in a Puppy Class are eligible to compete.

### **BEST VETERAN CLASS ELIGIBILITY**

Best Veteran will be selected from the Veteran Class winners following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated in a Veteran Class are eligible to compete.

### **AMATEUR OWNER HANDLER CLASS ELIGIBILITY**

For non-champion dogs at least 6 months of age. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. Entry is limited to exhibitors who have never been a professional handler, an AKC-approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13 of the AKC Dog Show Rules). *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs to a professional handlers' organization, distributes rate cards, or otherwise advertise or represent themselves as handling dogs for pay.*

### **BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY**

All dogs entered in the Bred-By Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class.

### **NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES**

***NOTE: Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class for Best of Breed Competition.***

#### **VETERAN CLASS**

**\*Veteran Dog Class      \*Veteran Bitch Class**

*A class for dogs and a class for bitches that are:*

*7 years & under 10 years, 10 years and under 12 years, 12 years and under 14 years, 14 years of age or older.*

**\*Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class."**

### **NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES**

**Stud Dog Class** – For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class, will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his get and be entered in the Stud Dog Class.

**Brood Bitch Class** – For bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not be the owner of the produce. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merit of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with her produce and be entered in the Brood Bitch Class.

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## BCCSC Breed Trophies

### Specialty Challenge Trophies

The following Challenge Trophies will be offered by the Bearded Collie Club of Southern California for competition at this Specialty: For permanent possession of a Challenge Trophy it must be won (3) times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog nor at consecutive shows. The year, name of the winning dog and name of the dog's owner will be engraved on the trophy which will remain in the custody of the BCCSC until retired. It is the owner's responsibility to notify the Trophy Chairperson of the third win.

**Best of Breed:** A Bearded Collie composite mounted on a wood base.

**Best of Opposite Sex:** A bronze Bearded Collie mounted on a wood base.

**Best of Winners:** A bronze Bearded Collie mounted on a wood base.

**Best in Puppy Sweepstakes:** the Sandy Ellington Memorial Trophy is offered: A bronze Bearded Collie statue on a wood and brass plaque.

**Best in Veteran Sweepstakes:** the Sandy Ellington Memorial Trophy is offered: A bronze Bearded Collie statue on a wood and brass plaque.

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## SWEEPSTAKES ~ PUPPY & VETERAN

**PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES ELIGIBILITY:** The Sweepstakes is open to all Bearded Collies, who, on the day of the show, will be at least 6 months and under 20 months of age. Judging will be held before the Regular Classes. All dogs entered in Sweepstakes MUST BE entered in a Regular Class or for Best of Breed at this show. Entry fee is \$20.00 in addition to the Regular Entry Fee. Entry in the Sweepstakes must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as for the Regular Classes.

Write SWEEPSTAKES in the "Additional Class" space and state the AGE DIVISION.

### CLASSIFICATION ~ PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

The following age division classes are offered for both Dogs and Bitches:

*6 months and under 9 months ~ 9 months and under 12 months;  
12 months and under 15 months ~ 15 months and under 20 months*

**VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES ELIGIBILITY:** The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Bearded Collies, who, on the day of the show, will be at least 7 years of age or older. Entry fee is \$20.00. Write VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES in the "Additional Class" space and state the AGE DIVISION.

### CLASSIFICATION ~ VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

The following age division classes are offered for both Dogs and Bitches:

*7 years and under 10 years ~ 10 years and under 12 years  
12 years and under 14 years ~ 14 years and older*

**SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY:** Division of Money: 35% of the total entry fee will be retained by the BCCSC to defray expenses. The remaining 65% will be distributed as follows: 15% to Best Veteran in Sweepstakes, 10% to Best Opposite Sex to the Best Veteran, 15% to Best Puppy, 10% to Best of Opposite Sex to the Best in Puppy, and the remainder shall be divided equally between the class winners.

*All prize money is paid in the ring to the person handling the dog.

## **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

1. Entries must reach the Show Secretary, Doris Bandoian, 1220 N. Richfield Rd., Anaheim, CA 92807-1812, by NOON, (PT) Wednesday, March 14, 2018. Fees should accompany entries. The Club and the Show Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. The Club and the Show Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agent entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.
2. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The CLUB will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check **MUST BE MADE GOOD** by cash or money order **BEFORE** the dog will be allowed in the ring.
3. Exhibitors' confirmations and judging programs will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the Show Secretary. Confirmations returned by the Post Office marked "Undeliverable" will be held at the Show Secretary's office. **PLEASE BRING YOUR CONFIRMATIONS TO THE SHOW.**
4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly in order that judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owner of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, it's owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of these clubs nor the American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 6 AM to 8 PM.
5. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging ring by completion of the breed and the show secretaries office advised at once, in the event of any discrepancy. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
6. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany the premium list. Rule books are available online at [www.akc.org](http://www.akc.org).
7. The Club, the Show Secretary or the members or employees will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor/owner or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler/agent during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
8. No grooming tables, pens or exhibitors setups will be allowed in the aisles and all grooming must be done at least 20 ft. away from the judging ring in areas specified by the club.
9. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Event Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fees for duplicate entry.
10. Only dogs that are eligible to compete to be allowed on the grounds.
11. The Bearded Collie Club of Southern California, may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
12. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
13. **Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.**
14. A recording fee of 50 cents per dog and an event service fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show.
