### BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

### GRAND CHAMPION SELECT

Champions of Record and dogs which have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed that are entered in Best of Breed competition are eligible for Grand Championship competition. Grand Championship points may be recorded for: Best of Breed or Best of Variety of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed or Best of Variety of Breed, Select Dog, and Select Bitch. Grand Championship points will be recorded according to the number of eligible dogs competing in the regular and non-regular (eligible for Best of Breed/Variety) classes of each breed or variety, as well as dogs competing in Best of Breed competition, according to the Schedule of Points established by the Board of Directors. (*AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 16, Section 6, effective 11-01-2017*)

### AWARD OF MERIT

The Italian Greyhound Club of America, Inc. is offering Awards of Merit to enable judges, at their discretion to recognize and acknowledge deserving exhibits in Best of Breed competition, but who were not awarded Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex. The number of awards will be as follows: One Award of Merit Minimum 5-9 Champions. Two Awards of Merit 10-14 Champions. Three Awards of Merit 15-19 Champions. Four Awards of Merit 20 or more Champions.

### BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY

All dogs entered in the Bred-By Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class. Best Bred-By Exhibitor will be selected from the Bred-By-Exhibitor winners following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated in the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class are eligible to compete.

### BEST VETERAN CLASS ELIGIBILITY

Best Veteran will be selected from the Veteran Class winners following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated in a Veteran Class are eligible to compete.

### BEST IN BRACE

Best Brace will be the winner of the Brace Class.

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

**NOTE: Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class for Best of Breed Competition.**

Veteran 7 years & under 10 years and 10 year & older (classes divided by sex)

**\*Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class."**

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

**NOTE: As the judges' decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won any of these classes.**

**\* STUD DOG CLASS** - For Stud Dogs and at least two of their Get but not more than four. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get MUST be entered in one of the regular conformation classes or for Best of Breed Competition. No Stud Dog or his Get may be shown as a part of another unit. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed.

**\* BROOD BITCH CLASS** - Same as for the Stud Dog Class except substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog" and "Produce" for "Get."

**\* Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."**

**\* Brace Class** - For two Italian Greyhounds with one common owner. **Entry is \$16.00 per dog** and must be made using two (2) complete entry forms, one for each dog in the brace.

**ATTENTION EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS**

Exercising pens will not be allowed in congested areas.

No bathing, no blow dryers or any electrical grooming tools will be allowed in Judging Buildings.

Paid Grooming facilities will be provided in a separate building or outdoors.

Riding other modes of transportation, with the exception of legitimately licensed handicapped units,

are not allowed on the fair grounds. This includes: scooters, motorized or not, roller blades,

wheeled handicapped vehicles.

**PARKING INFORMATION**

All parking is at your own risk. Seaside Park and the show-giving clubs assume no responsibility for loss or damage to vehicles or their contents.

**DAY PARKING:** Seaside Park will collect a fee of \$5.00 per car and parking will be in designated lots only. A controlled loading zone is provided; vehicles must be removed promptly. Lights must be left on and keys in the ignition while vehicle is in the loading zone.

**RESERVED PARKING** is a privilege extended by the Ventura County Dog Fanciers Association. It may be withdrawn from any person who does not abide by the rules or who uses abusive language or tactics.

Authorized personnel will assist parking all motor homes.

All vehicles must have a working fire extinguisher, be self-contained and no discharging of holding tanks is allowed at Seaside Park.

- No electrical cords will be permitted across paths or roadways.
- Any persons who break open lock boxes or otherwise damages property in order to find electricity will be held financially responsible; will be subject to an event committee hearing and asked to leave. Fees will not be refunded.
- No running of generators between 10 PM and 6 AM
- Those wishing to park together must send request and full fee together in same envelope, however there is no guarantee we can accommodate all requests.
- Spaces are approximately **22' X 40'**. Any vehicle or combination of vehicles greater than 40' must reserve two spaces.
- Tag-a-long vehicles will be charged \$5.00 per night. One tag vehicle per space. Those not fitting in the parking space allocated will be required to park elsewhere.
- All reserved parking is on asphalt and conveniently located; there is no designated handicapped parking.

A Rosette for Best Owner-Handler will be presented.

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be conducted following Best of Breed judging. All dogs in the BOB competition (including WD & WB) will stay in the ring after the judge makes their placements in BOB competition. The ring steward will ask all professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handler to leave the ring and then the judge will then select the Best Owner-Handled (BOH). The dog and its owner will continue to accrue points for any group placements or Bests in Show.

The top-ranked dogs from the AKC National Owner-Handled Series are posted on the [AKC National Owner-Handled Series Points Ranking](#) page. Rankings of the dogs competing in the Series are compiled based on the Best of Breed, Group, and Best in Show placements in this specific Series competition ([See Point Schedule](#)). The end of year competition for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be held in conjunction with the AKC/Royal Canin show in December. Dogs that finished ranked in the top ten (plus ties) for their breed during the qualifying period will be invited to compete in the competition. Dogs exhibited by professional handlers on the day of the event are not eligible for this competition. Dogs exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler on the day of the event are not eligible to enter this competition.

**Professional handlers** are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. Entries must reach the Show Secretary, Doris Bandoian, 1220 N. Richfield Rd., Anaheim, CA 92807-1812, by NOON (PDT), Wednesday, April 25, 2018. Fees should accompany entries. The Club and the Show Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. The Club and the Show Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agent entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.
2. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The CLUB will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.
3. Exhibitors' confirmations and judging programs will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the Show Secretary. Confirmations returned by the Post Office marked "Undeliverable" will be held at the Show Secretary's office. PLEASE BRING YOUR CONFIRMATIONS TO THE SHOW.
4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly in order that judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owner of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, it's owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of these clubs nor the American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 7 AM to 6 PM.
5. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging ring by completion of the breed and the show secretaries office advised at once, in the event of any discrepancy. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
6. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany the premium list. Rule books may be obtained online from the A.K.C., [www.AKC.org](http://www.AKC.org).
7. The Club, the Show Secretary or the members or employees will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor/owner or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler/agent during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
8. No grooming tables, pens or exhibitors setups will be allowed in the aisles and all grooming must be done at least 20 ft. away from the judging ring in areas specified by the club.
9. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Event Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fees for duplicate entry.
10. Only dogs that are eligible to compete to be allowed on the grounds.
11. The Italian Greyhound Club Of America, Inc., may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
12. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
13. **Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.**
14. A recording fee of 50 cents per dog and an event service fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show.
