RESERVED GROOMING TENTS

Tented Reserved grooming space is available for \$60.00 per space through WheresMySpace.com. All reserved Tented grooming Spaces are approximately 10 x 10 feet. Reserved grooming spaces will be reserved from Wednesday after 2pm thru Sunday; however, "your" space will be reserved for your arrival on any day of the cluster.

Tented Reserved grooming spaces will be under the provided grooming tents. No electricity will be provided. Exhibitors and/or handlers are responsible to provide their own generators. The Kennel Club

of Palm Springs, Circuit clubs, club members or service providers assume no responsibility for damage/ theft of items or injury to dogs at the show.

X-pens placed in your space under the tent must have plastic sheeting come up approximately 18" on the backs and sides of exercise pens. X-pens placed adjacent to the grooming tents MUST not block aisle or access to grooming spaces. Remember to keep your space clean. The grooming tents will be checked each night for cleanliness. The Show Chairman and Show Committee reserve the right to make all decisions concerning assignment of the reserved grooming spaces.

"BRING YOUR OWN CANOPY" reserved grooming spaces will be available by reservation only after 2PM on Wednesday. There will be a TOTAL of only 40 of these spaces. Bring your own canopy stakes and generator. Cost for the "BYOC" reserved grooming is \$40.00 per space through WheresMySpace.com. These spaces are **un-tented but reserved**.

Late fee of \$15 per 10x10 will be added for reservations received after December 26, 2018. Online grooming reservations will close when all spaces are sold or December 26, 2018, whichever comes first. Please select the grooming tent you want to be under. The committee will arrange reservations under the tents. Please note on the online for if you have box truck parking. If you wish to be adjacent to another exhibitor, please make your online reservations together or indicate request online in comments section. If you reserve different tents, we cannot move you next to one another.

Mailed in Reservations

There is no guarantee on tent location when mailing reservations. The Online Reservation System website www.WheresMySpace.com is highly recommended when making your reservation. If you wish to be adjacent to another exhibitor, please send or make your reservations together or indicate request online in comments section. Every effort will be made to optimize the placement of your space. Exhibitors should have no expectation of being adjacent to any specific exhibitor or ring. One check and form per space or person. Request to set up next to each other must be mailed in the same envelope (No exceptions). All attempts will be made to accommodate requested locations but with No Guarantees. Mailed in reservations should note the tent location preferences. If your desired tent is sold out, the next closest tent will be used. If all of our reserved spaces are filled, your request and payment will be returned. RESERVE YOUR SPACE ONLINE at www.WheresMySpace.com.

Day Crating Areas:

THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL MARK DAY CRATING AREAS. The Show Committee reserves the right to consolidate spaces or move exhibitors' items to accommodate other exhibitors. USE OF DRYERS, ELECTRICAL HOOKUP, SCISSORING, BATHING OF DOGS OR OVERNIGHT SETUP IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED IN THE DAY CRATING AREAS OF THE MAIN SHOW TENTS. AISLES MUST BE KEPT CLEAR. The Show Committee will designate holding areas near the rings for exhibitors to put crates and tables and Dollies while they are showing. Only approved reserved grooming and non-reserved space may be used for grooming.

NON RESERVED GROOMING AREA Although grooming reservations are recommended, the Kennel Club of Palm Springs has free grooming areas, without power in the grass areas. Non Reserved Grooming areas will be indicated by signs and are available for set up after 2PM on Wednesday. There is NO FREE GROOMING AREAS UNDER THE GROOMING TENTS. Please bring your own shade. Spaces might be limited - arrive early. The Show Committee reserves the right to consolidate spaces to accommodate exhibitors.

Reservations must be received no later than December 26, 2018. Late fee of \$15 per 10x10 will be added for reservations received after December 26, 2018. Fees will not be refunded and reservations cannot be changed after December 26, 2018. Each **Tented** 10' x 10' spot = \$60. (I.e. 10 x 20 = \$120; 10 x 30 = \$180, etc.). NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. Entries must reach the Event Secretary, M.L. (Peggy) Butler, 34743 The Farm Road, Wildomar, CA 92595, by 12:00 Noon, Wednesday, December 19, 2018. Fees should accompany entries. The Club and the Event Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. The Club and the Event Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agent entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.
 2. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Event Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.
 3. Exhibitors' confirmations and judging programs will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the Event Secretary. Confirmations returned by the Post Office marked "Undeliverable" will be held at the Event Secretary's office. **PLEASE BRING YOUR CONFIRMATIONS TO THE SHOW.**
 4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly in order that judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owner of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, it's owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of these clubs nor the American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.
 5. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of the breed and the superintendents office advised at once, in the event of any discrepancy. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
 6. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany the premium list. Rule books may be obtained from the A.K.C., 5580 Centerview Dr. Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606.
 7. The Club, the Event Secretary or the members or employees will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor/owner or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler/agent during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
 8. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Event Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fees for duplicate entry.
 9. The San Bernardino - Riverside Poodle Club, may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
 10. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
 11. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.
 12. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the Closing of entries for a show must transfer their entry from Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.
 13. No practicing allowed in rings at any time.
 14. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Event Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Confirmation judging at the show.
 15. Individual canopies/pop-ups may not block the ingress or egress to tented grooming areas.
 16. Parents and/or guardians are responsible for the actions of their children.
- ADDITIONAL RULES** governing this show are on the back of the entry blank and in the AKC Rules and Regulations.

DAY OF SHOW PARKING INFORMATION

Note: There are unloading areas at each end of the show grounds.

Valet parking will be available, beginning on Friday, at a charge of \$20.00 per day per vehicle.

Some parking areas may be some distance from your ring(s). An unloading area will be provided. Please follow the instructions of parking attendants. Day-of-Show parking will be \$10.00 per space. Vehicles requiring more than one space (motor homes, etc.) will be parked in the day-of-show overflow parking lot and will be charged \$10.00 per space used. No overnight parking will be allowed in the day of show parking lots. Anyone not following KCPS rules risks having his/her vehicle towed at owners' expense. No abusive behavior will be tolerated. KCPS and Empire Polo Club assume no responsibility for fire, theft or damage to vehicles or cargo, whether legally or illegally parked. Overnight parking is not permitted on the streets in Indio. Valet parking will be available.

Towing Policy. Cars parked in the unloading zone will be towed without any public announcement.

The towing fee will be **\$50.00**, plus the \$10 day-of-show parking fee.

ELECTRICAL POWER INFORMATION

POWER WILL BE AVAILABLE IN OVERNIGHT PARKING AREAS ONLY. The cost is \$60.00 (for 30 amps) per night – 2-night minimum (or \$120.00 for two 30-amps, per night – 2 night minimum). Requests for power not made in advance, will be \$10.00 more (cash), per night. Please make your check payable to Powertrip, but mail it to Ron Mattson. You may use your own generator if you so choose. Assignments to parking lots will be made in the order that reservations are received, and NO ELECTRICAL POWER REFUNDS WILL BE MADE. IF YOU ARRIVE BEFORE 5 PM ON CHECK-IN DAY AND PLUG INTO POWER, YOU WILL BE CHARGED FOR AN EXTRA DAY OF POWER USAGE, PER POWERTRIP. Any damage to Powertrip equipment will be the responsibility of the user. Payment must be made at the time of the occurrence.

NO UNATTENDED SOFT CRATES ALLOWED ON SHOW GROUNDS.

The use of Flexi-leads is not permitted on the show grounds,
except in the Obedience practice ring.

OVERNIGHT PARKING INFORMATION

There are two overnight parking areas: one is adjacent to the show area and one is some distance away. Most of the parking is on decomposed granite. Spaces assigned in order received. No dumping of gray water or sewage is allowed. There will be a \$25.00 charge for any returned checks.

Please note the following parking requirements/restrictions:

1. Those wishing to park together must arrive together.
2. Space changing will not be permitted. All vehicles must park as directed by parking personnel.
3. Confirmation of your reservation will be sent if you enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope.
4. All personal generators must be turned off between 11 pm and 6 am daily.
5. All tag vehicle operators will be required to purchase a tag vehicle pass (\$20.00 for the weekend).
6. Tag vehicles must fit into assigned space, not aisle.
7. Any motor home over 40' long must have two spaces.
8. Any truck & trailer over 40' must have two spaces, or unhook; note on form.
9. All parking spaces are 22' wide by 35' long; over 35' will be parked in designated rows.
10. No foul or abusive language will be tolerated; anyone not following parking rules will be asked to leave, and no refunds will be given.
11. **ALL POWER DRIVEN CONVENIENCE DEVICES USED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS MUST DISPLAY A KCPS CERTIFICATE OF PROOF OF INSURANCE. OTHER POWER-DRIVEN MOBILITY DEVICES (OPDM) AS DEFINED BY THE ADA ARE EXEMPT FROM KCPS CERTIFICATION.**

No parking refunds will be made after close of entries. **All parking reservations must be received by December 19, 2018. Reservations received after that date will cost an additional \$10.00 per night.**
